Cheryl Renee Lero, age 65, of Houston departed this life on April 20, 2026 after a brief battle with cancer. She was born on April 6, 1961 to Fred and Patricia Gorski Lero. Born and raised Catholic, she attended St. Theresa Catholic School through the 8th grade and was a 1979 graduate of St. Pius X High School.

Cheryl graduated from the University of Houston in 1993 with a BS degree in Psychology. She recently retired from Air Liquide after more than 40 years of loyal service in their legal department.

Cheryl was preceded in death by her father, Fred Lero, her paternal grandparents Louis and Ima Belle Caraway Lero, and her maternal grandparents Ike and Louise Philips Gorski.
